**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
SUPPORTING THE COSUMNES POWER PLANT PROJECT PROPOSED BY
SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT (SMUD)**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove is pleased to endorse the Cosumnes Power Plant, a project proposed by the Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) in the southern portion of Sacramento County; and

WHEREAS, SMUD has a proven record of providing the Sacramento region with reliable, low-cost electricity in an environmentally responsible manner; and

WHEREAS, SMUD needs to construct an additional power plant in the region to ensure voltage support, minimize service disruptions, and increase base load power for a growing economy; and

WHEREAS, SMUD's plant design has appropriately factored in critical environmental and economic considerations. The Cosumnes Power Plant has been designed to use state-of-the-art equipment and water-cooling to maximize efficiency, minimize the consumption of nonrenewable natural gas, and minimize air and noise pollution.


