**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AMENDING THE 2001-02 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET
TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RETAIN A PUBLIC RELATIONS FIRM
TO OPPOSE AB680**

WHEREAS, the passage of AB680 would have a profound impact on the collection of sales tax revenues generated within the City of Elk Grove; and

WHEREAS, the loss of sales tax revenues would diminish the quality of municipal services provided to the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove intends to join a broad-based consortium of concerned cities in California which has pledged funds to oppose passage of AB680;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove does hereby approve a budget amendment in the amount of \$15,000 from the 2001-02 Fiscal Year Budget General Fund Reserve to Account No. 100-50511-1100 (Federal/State Lobbyists) for the purpose of retaining a public relations firm to oppose the passage of AB680.

PASSED AND ADOPTED, this 9th day of January 2002.




