TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE LOS RIOS COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT**


WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove City Council endorses higher education as provided by the Los Rios Community College District; and

WHEREAS, general obligation bonds is a mechanism which can be utilized to provide affordable, top quality education and job training opportunities for Elk Grove residents;


