**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A GRANT
AWARD AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AND THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE
FOR FUNDS FROM THE COPS UNIVERSAL HIRING PROGRAM (UHP)**

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City accept the \$1,350,000 grant award from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Universal Hiring Program (UHP);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Administrative Services Director appropriate \$1,650,000 for the police department annually from the City's General Fund for the three-year grant period for matching funds and associated first-year startup costs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager or his designee is directed to execute all contracts, reports and other documents required for receiving such funds pursuant to the terms and conditions of the COPS Universal Hiring program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the recruitment of 18 additional officers to the City's law enforcement contract with Sacramento County is authorized and that the City will assume full financial responsibility and maintain all 18 UHP grant funded officer positions and equipment immediately following the three-year grant period for at least one full budget cycle.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
