**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
APPROVING THE REQUEST FOR A PUBLIC CONVENIENCE  
AND NECESSITY LETTER FOR A CHEVRON STATION  
AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LAGUNA BOULEVARD AND  
LAGUNA SPRINGS DRIVE FOR A TYPE 20  
(OFF-SALE BEER AND WINE) LICENSE  
PROJECT #EG-02-286**

WHEREAS, Chevron (hereinafter referred to as Applicant) filed an application with the City of Elk Grove (hereinafter referred to as City) for a Public Convenience and Necessity Letter to obtain a Type 20 Off-sale alcohol license (beer and wine) (Assessor's Parcel Numbers 116-0330-021); and

WHEREAS, Title 4, Chapter 4.60, of the City of Elk Grove Municipal Code establishes the City Council as the appropriate authority to hear and decide all Public Convenience and Necessity Letters; and

WHEREAS, the project is exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15061(3); and

WHEREAS, a duly advertised public hearing notice; in accordance with Government Code Section 65090 et al. and a public hearing was conducted by the City Council on June 5, 2002.

WHEREAS, after careful consideration of all the written materials and testimony received, the City Council approved the project.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Approve the request for a Type 20 Off-sale alcohol license (beer and wine).


