**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
APPROVING A PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY LETTER  
LONGS DRUG STORE, PROJECT #EG-03-422**

**WHEREAS**, Longs Drug Store (hereinafter referred to as Applicant) filed an application with the City of Elk Grove (hereinafter referred to as City) for a Public Convenience and Necessity Letter to obtain a Type 21 Off-sale alcohol license (Assessor Parcel Number 127-0170-052); and

**WHEREAS**, Title 4, Chapter 4.60, of the City of Elk Grove Municipal Code establishes the City Council as the appropriate authority to hear and decide all Public Convenience and Necessity Letters; and

**WHEREAS**, the project is exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15061 (3); and

**WHEREAS**, a duly advertised public hearing notice; in accordance with Government Code section 65090 et al. and a public hearing was conducted by the City Council on June 4, 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration of all the written materials and testimony received, the City Council approved the project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby resolves as follows:


1. Approves the request for a Type 21 Off-sale alcohol license.


