

RESOLUTION NO. 2003-204

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE, TO
UTILIZE THE STATE CITIZEN'S OPTION FOR PUBLIC SAFETY PROGRAM FUNDS**

WHEREAS, under the State Supplemental Funding for Local Law Enforcement, the State appropriated funding for local law enforcement operations and services for FY 03-04; and

WHEREAS, Elk Grove's portion of the SLESF funding is anticipated to be approximately \$172,000; and

WHEREAS, under the condition of the program, the City of Elk Grove shall use SLESF funds exclusively to support front-line police operations and services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, at a public hearing held on October 15, 2003, considered these written requests separate and apart from the process applicable to propose allocations of the City General Fund.


