

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DIRECTING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PURSUE DELIVERY OF VARIOUS
PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE IMPROVEMENTS TO BE FUNDED BY FEDERAL
CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY PROGRAM FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove will implement and carry out various pedestrian and bicycle improvements throughout the City of Elk Grove; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2003 the City of Elk Grove executed Program Supplement Agreement Number 002-M to Administering Agency-State Agreement Number 03-5479 providing for the receipt of Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program Funds for various pedestrian and bicycle improvements throughout the City of Elk Grove; and

WHEREAS, through Resolution 2003-184, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorized the City Engineer to undertake all actions necessary to undertake and complete the work defined by said agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has developed a prioritized list of recommended improvements (Exhibit 1) that are eligible for funding from the Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby directs the City Engineer to pursue delivery of eligible projects based on the priorities set forth in Exhibit 1, except that the priority for a given project may be adjusted if technical, environment or financial constraints are identified that would significantly hinder the ability to deliver the project within the timing and/or financial constraints of the Federal funding source.
