A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING PAVEMENT REPAIRS – GRANT LINE ROAD (MP2304) AND 2023 PAVEMENT SLURRY SEAL RESURFACING PHASE 4 (WPR023); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH A.TEICHERT & SON, INC. FOR THE COMBINED PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,647,167.15; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$164,720; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS (CEQA EXEMPT)

WHEREAS, the Pavement Repairs – Grant Line Road (MP2304) and 2023 Pavement Slurry Seal Resurfacing Phase 4 (WPR023) (Project) includes removal and replacement of existing failed pavement with new hot mix asphalt pavement and restriping of Grant Line Road from Bradshaw Road to Calvine Road; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on April 7, 2023 and April 14, 2023, and electronic bids were received on May 4, 2023; and

WHEREAS, A. Teichert & Son, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, George Reed, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the second lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2022-27 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2022-23 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

 Finds the Pavement Repairs – Grant Line Road (MP2304) and 2023 Pavement Slurry Seal Resurfacing Phase 4 (WPR023) Projects exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. This Project involves the removal and replacement of existing failed pavement with hot mix asphalt (HMA) and restriping of an existing roadway. As the Project involves maintenance activities

to existing infrastructure and will involve no expansion of use, it qualifies for the identified exemption and no additional environmental review under CEQA is required; and

- 2) Approves the Project; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with A. Teichert & Son, Inc. for the Pavement Repairs Grant Line Road (MP2304) and 2023 Pavement Slurry Seal Resurfacing Phase 4 (WPR023) Projects in the amount of \$1,647,167.15 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and
- 4) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$164,720; and
- 5) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest responsive bidder, George Reed, Inc., if, A. Teichert & Son, Inc., does not meet filing obligations.
