# SPECIAL MEETING AFFORDABLE HOUSING COMMITTEE Wednesday, June 9, 2021 | 2:00pm

Consistent with Executive Order N-29-20 issued on March 17, 2020, and Executive Order N-35-20 issued on March 21, 2020, by the Governor of the State of California, this meeting will be conducted by teleconference only. The meeting location will be Elk Grove City Hall, but it will not be open to the public.

This meeting will be conducted on the Zoom Meetings platform, which allows participation either via the internet using a computer or internet-capable mobile device or via telephone using a landline or mobile phone. The three-minute limit will be strictly observed for all oral comments made during the meeting. Each commenter may provide one three-minute comment per item.

Members of the public may also provide public comment ahead of the meeting by submitting those comments in writing or in mp3 format (audio) prior to the meeting by emailing such format to the Affordable Housing Committee administrative assistant at iscott@elkgrovecity.org. Alternatively, comments may be provided by leaving a voicemail at 916-478-2254. Such comments must be received by noon on the day of the Affordable Housing Committee meeting to be provided to the full Affordable Housing Committee and staff, and to be posted on the City website. Written and audio comments will not be read or played back during the public comment period for a particular agenda item unless directed by the Affordable Housing Committee. Members of the public are encouraged to submit their written and/or audio comments as far in advance of the meeting as reasonably practical.
