Shoaib Ahrary explained what the City's current curb ramp standards are based upon and how roadwork often triggers upgrading 100-150 ramps each year. He described the changes being made to the standards which would make those

standards even more stringent and accessible for those with disabilities. Ted made a motion to have Jim prepare a letter of support, and use Ted's electronic signature stamp to sign it. Bruce seconded the motion. It passed Unanimously.
