

INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

The California Solid Waste Reuse and Recycling Access Act requires new commercial, multi-family, and HDR single family residential developments of 5 units or more, or improvements that add 30% or more to the existing floor area to include adequate, accessible, and convenient areas for collecting and loading recyclable materials.

ENCLOSURE GUIDELINES

1. Provide an estimate of the amount of capacity required. Recycling capacity should equal 50% of capacity.
2. Provide a diagram showing dimensions with the location and placement of enclosures. Diagram should include enough space for collection vehicle to access enclosures.
3. Commercial use must design enclosures at a minimum for 3-yard containers, and a maximum distance of 250 feet from the nearest point of the building serviced.
4. Residential use must design enclosures with a pedestrian gate or walk through that does not necessitate opening of large gates used for servicing containers or a walk through wide enough to accommodate ADA requirements.
5. Summary of the waste management services to be provided at the location.
