Notice of Upcoming Release of Request for Proposal

Consulting Procurement for Preliminary Engineering and Environmental Services for the Grant Line Road and Wilton Road Operational Improvements Project (WTR091)

The City of Elk Grove, Public Works Department, will be requesting a detailed proposal from firms qualified to provide Preliminary Engineering and Environmental services for the City of Elk Grove Grant Line Road and Wilton Road Operational Improvements Project (WTR091) for the PA&ED Phase of the project with an option to extend the Professional Engineering Services into the Final Design, Right-Of-Way and Construction Support phases. Funding for the Professional Engineering Services will be with Federal and Local Funds and as such, this procurement will follow the federal aid selection process. This project will extend to the conclusion of the PA&ED resulting in an approved Environmental Document. Project elements include construction of an improved intersection of Grant Line Road and Wilton Road with a signal modification or roundabout incorporating four, median separated through lanes and multi-use trail on and along the Grant Line Road alignment. It also includes the possible realignment of Wilton Road to the south along Grant Line Road, modifications to the intersections of Grant Line Road and Pleasant Grove School Road, Aleilani Road and Grant Line Road, Wilton Road and Leisure Oak Lane, and adjacent commercial and residential driveways.

City staff will provide right of way support services for the project.

The Consultant will provide Preliminary Engineering and Environmental services including but not limited to the following:

- I. Project management including quality control
- 2. Public outreach, including public workshops or hearings
- 3. Boundary, aerial and topographical surveys
- Civil engineering design to 35% including interchange and roadway geometrics, drainage, hydraulics including FEMA Floodplain coordination, traffic control, staging, erosion control, utility relocations, etc.
- Prepare NEPA and CEQA environmental documents, technical studies, etc.
- 6. Traffic engineering including signals, illumination, signing and striping
- 7. Geotechnical investigations and report
- 8. Utility relocation coordination (including potholing if necessary)
