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Summary

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Summary

The National Citizen Survey[™] (The NCS) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The National Citizen Survey communities. This report discusses trends over time, comparing the 2013 ratings for the City of Elk Grove to its previous survey results in 2009 and 2011. Additional reports and technical appendices are available under separate cover.

Trend data for Elk Grove represent important comparison data and should be examined for improvements or declines. Deviations from stable trends over time, especially, represent opportunities for understanding how local policies, programs or public information may have affected residents' opinions.

Meaningful differences between survey years have been noted within the following tables as being "higher" or "lower" if the differences are greater than eight percentage points, otherwise the comparison between 2011 and 2013 are noted as being "similar." Additionally benchmark comparison for all survey years are presented for reference. Changes in the benchmark comparison over time can be impacted by various trends, including varying survey cycles for the individual communities that comprise the benchmarks; regional and national economic or other events; as well as emerging survey methodologies.

Overall, ratings in Elk Grove for 2013 generally remained stable. Of the 81 items for which comparisons were available, 59 items were rated similarly in 2011 and 2013, 20 items showed an increase in ratings and two showed a decrease in ratings. Notable trends over time included the following:

- Most of the General Community Characteristics remained stable over time, however ratings for the overall image or reputation of Elk Grove and Elk Grove as a place to retire increased in 2013 when compared to 2011.
- Most facets of the Community Characteristics remained stable between 2011 and 2013. Increases in ratings were in the area of Mobility with the availability of paths and walking trails and ease of walking in Elk Grove both showing improvement from 2011. Within Natural Environment, the quality of the overall natural environment and air quality increased.
- In the area of Governance, Community Engagement saw increases in the overall direction of Elk Grove and the job the City does in welcoming citizen involvement.
- Participation saw increases in the likelihood of respondents to remain in Elk Grove and to recommend Elk Grove as a place to live.
