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Summary

The National Citizen Survey[™] (The NCS[™]) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by length of residency, housing tenure, sex, presence of children in the household and presence of adults age 65 or older in the household.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as "excellent" or "good," or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A "p-value" of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are "real." Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for this report is generally no greater than plus or minus six percentage points around any given percent reported for the entire sample (275 completed surveys). For subgroups of responses, the margin of error increases because the sample size for the subgroup is smaller. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- Within the pillar of Community Characteristics, residents who had lived in Elk Grove for five years or less or were female tended to give higher ratings to aspects of Safety, Economy, Community Engagement and to general aspects of Community Characteristics than their counterparts. Respondents who had children living in the household gave higher ratings to the overall ease of getting to places they usually have to visit, but lower ratings to the overall feeling of safety in Elk Grove, ease of public parking and the availability of affordable quality child care/preschool than those without children. Within the facet of Built Environment, residents who had lived in Elk Grove for six years or more gave higher ratings to the variety of housing options than their counterparts, while residents who had lived in the City for five years or less were more likely to give positive ratings to the overall quality of new development than those who had lived in Elk Grove for a longer time.
- Resident opinion by demographic groups tended to vary across facets of Governance. Male residents were less likely than female residents to give positive ratings to general aspects of Governance, and households with children tended to give fewer positive ratings to aspects of Natural Environment than households without children. Within the facet of Safety, residents with children in the household rated police/Sheriff services, crime prevention and emergency preparedness less positively than households without children, but gave higher ratings to animal control. Those who had lived in Elk Grove for 10 years or less tended to give higher ratings to street repair and code enforcement than those who had lived in the City longer.
- Within the pillar of Participation, residents who had lived in Elk Grove for five years or less tended to give higher ratings for the sense of community in the City than their counterparts and were also more likely to remain in Elk Grove for the next five years or to recommend living in Elk Grove to someone who asked. Residents who had lived in Elk Grove for five years or less, owned their homes or were male were less likely to use public transportation instead of driving than their counterparts. In Community Engagement, residents who had lived in Elk Grove for six to 10 years were more likely to have campaigned or advocated for an issue, cause or candidate, contacted Elk Grove elected officials, done a favor for a neighbor or attended a local public meeting than residents who had lived in the City for more or less time.
