About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey™, the City of Elk Grove conducted a mailed survey of 2,700 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in late September 2017 and data were collected through mid-November. Toward the end of the official data collection period (see the report, *The National Citizen Survey: Community Livability Report, Elk Grove, CA, 2017*), the City made available a web-based survey to its residents through a link on the City's website. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey during November 2017 and 36 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the web-based survey that have not been weighted to current population estimates of Elk Grove.
